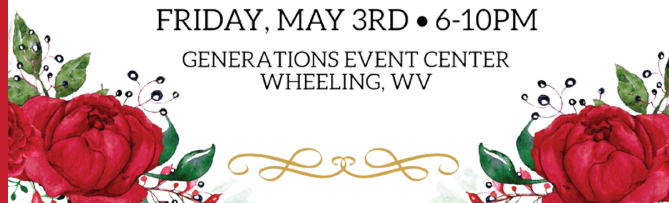

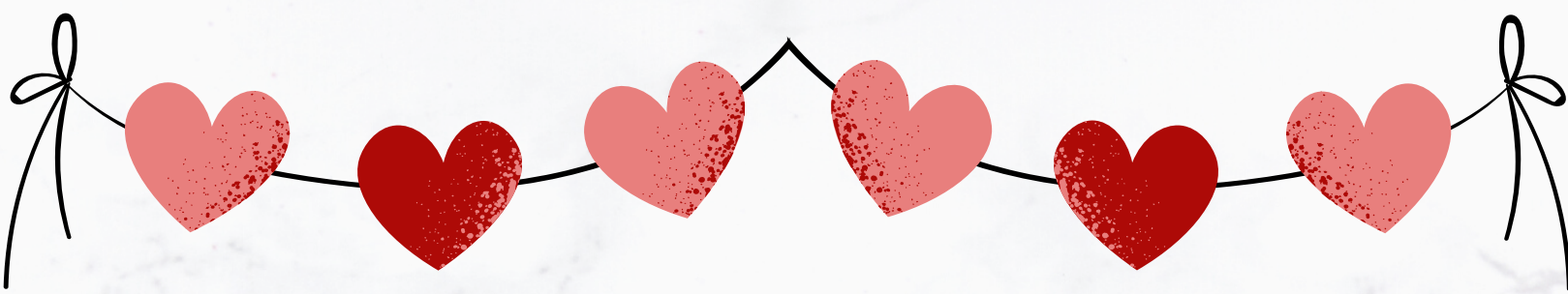

Q&A with an Elmhurst Resident

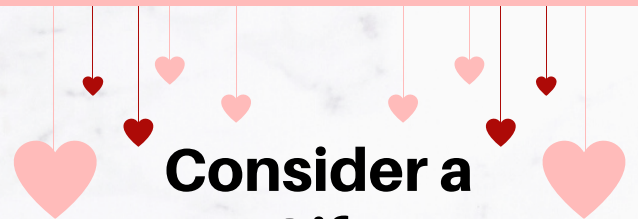
Q: What do you like most about living at Elmhurst?
